Purpose of the meeting was to hear a presentation by Daniel Richter, Graduate Student at the UCSD Scripps Institution of Oceanography on the topic of Global Climate Change

Climate Change:

Mr. Richter started by providing a hardcopy of “San Diego’s Changing Climate: A Regional Wake-Up Call”, a summary of the Focus 2050 study presented by The San Diego Foundation (<http://www.sdfoundation.org/Portals/0/Newsroom/PDF/Reports/Focus2050glossySDF-ClimateReport.pdf>), a comprehensive regional assessment of climate change impacts to San Diego County. After that, Mr. Richter provided a presentation which started from the three basic observations of a) why climate change exists, b) where it needs to be, and c) how do we get there. Throughout the presentation, questions were asked and discussions ensued.
