BUFFER BETWEEN PEDESTRIANS AND VEHICLES

ENHANCED COMMUNITY BENEFITS

- FREE FLOWING RIGHT HAND TURN LANE FROM SCOTT STREET TO HARBOR DRIVE REMAINS
- ENHANCED PUBLIC STREET PARKING OF 2-3 HOURS
- APPROXIMATELY 150 NEW PUBLIC PARKING SPACES
- HARBOR DRIVE REMAINS A 4 LANE MAJOR ROADWAY THAT COMPLIES W/CITY STANDARDS



PARKING STRUCTURE

- 4 LEVEL PARKING STRUCTURE (345 SPACES IN STRUCTURE & 55 SURFACE SPACES)
- PEDESTRIAN SIGNALIZED CROSSWALK FROM EAST SIDE OF HARBOR DR TO BAYSIDE
- COST TO COMPLETE \$8.5 MILLION TO BE PAID BY SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT
- CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN FALL 2011
