PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Substantial Conformance Review (Process 2) to Neighborhood Use Permit No.542163 and Coastal Development Permit No.554935 for a modification to an existing wireless facility. The antennas are located behind radio-frequency transparent material on an existing building. The building (Smee Hall) is located on the Pt. Loma Nazarene campus in the RS-1-7 zone within the Peninsula Community Planning Area.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego (Process 2).

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines, Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Development Services Staff.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an initial study which determined that the project consists of the minor alteration of existing Wireless Communication Facility (WCF) within an existing private structure involving negligible or no expansion of an existing use. The existing and proposed antennas are completely concealed from public view as they are located behind a radio-frequency transparent material attached to the building. None of the exceptions listed in CEQA Section 15300.2 would apply.
