RE: Froude and Voltaire Street

Safety is one of the greatest concerns for the residents and we thank the City for supporting Vision Zero and implementing safer pedestrian facilities throughout the City.

The intersection at Voltaire and Froude is one of the most dangerous intersections in the neighborhood and neighbors and residents have witnessed many accidents at this location. As a long term improvement, we believe better street design and traffic calming measures could drastically improve this area, but we understand the limitations of resources and funding.

Therefore, the Peninsula Community Planning Board would like to request a Flashing Beacon Light to be installed to cross Voltaire Street at Froude Street, including Continental Crosswalks. We recommend the Flashing Beacon Light be on the west side of Froude Street and that Continental Crosswalks to be included on Froude Street as well.

We believe this short term improvement can help improve the safety for all modes traveling this neighborhood street.

The Peninsula Community Planning Board looks forward to the City of San Diego's response to this requests within the next 45 days. Thank you for your consideration and collaboration for safer streets.
