Dear Neighbor:

I am writing this letter to update you on the planning process for proposed improvements at San Diego International Airport:

- **A draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR)** was released in October 2007 by the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority. The plan addresses near-term improvements designed to allow the airport to meet current passenger demand. These include a ten-gate build-out of Terminal 2; a dual-level roadway in front of Terminal 2; and various parking, roadway and airfield improvements.
- **The public comment period** has been extended for the draft EIR. Residents and other interested parties now have until January 4, 2008, to submit comments on the draft EIR. The public comment period was previously scheduled to conclude on November 30, 2007. The document is available on our new Web site www.sanplan.com; if you wish to look at a hard copy, contact the Airport Authority at 619-400-2400. Hard copies are also available at the Point Loma and Ocean Beach libraries.
