We will continue to support your office with the early turn data/explanations as we feel this is an important endeavor to achieve 100% compliance between SAN ATC, SCT ATC, and SDIA noise office.

I am pleased that I was able to provide support via the NTAG for completing the airports FAR Part 150 noise study. This was an achievement that all should be proud of.

As previously stated, all community requests for ATC procedures and/or occurrences must utilize the established FOIA process.

I will continue to share my knowledge of noise procedures with the constantly growing number of new controllers and emphasize the importance of community consciousness.
