

PENINSULA COMMUNITY PLANNING BOARD AIRPORT CONCERNS
Community Delegation meeting with Congresswoman Susan Davis
October 10, 2009
9:30 AM – 10:30 AM

Meeting held at 53rd District Office: 4305 University Ave. Ste 515, SD 92105(Conf. Room)

Meeting called to order by Chair Suhail Khalil at 9:30 a.m. and open discussions to address PCPB Letter dated August 28, 2009

Attendance: Congresswoman Susan A. Davis, Ricardo Flores (53rd District Community Representative), Suhail Khalil, Jay Shumaker, Paul Grimes (PCPB) and Joel Siegfried (Airport Examiner).

SDIA Topics of Concerns discussed:

Topics included projections that the airport would reach operational capacity by 2020, community concerns over noise mitigation and air quality, increased flight traffic along departure vector 250-degrees in addition to the other FAA departure vectors at 275, 290, and 310-degrees, the placement of an intermodal transit center in the airport's present Terminal Development Program which is scheduled for completion in 2012, future military base realignment and closures (BRAC), and other possible locations for San Diego International Airport in the aftermath of voters rejecting relocation of the airport to the current Marine Corps Air Station at Miramar.

Congresswoman Davis agreed to press SDCRAA & FAA to abide by California Auditors report in 2000 concerning noise mitigation departure gates and limit use of 250 degree departure headings. Davis agreed to update community regarding NAS Coronado increased operations and 2009 AICUZ report and future BRAC considerations in 2010-2011 that will effect our community.

Davis requested a follow-up letter to address specific action items. Khalil agreed to provide follow-up letter on behalf of PCPB Airport Committee.
