

**PENINSULA COMMUNITY PLANNING BOARD AIRPORT CONCERNS**  
**Community Delegation meeting with Senator Christine Kehoe**

**Meeting called to order by Chair Suhail Khalil at 2:00 p.m.**

**Addressed PCPB August 28, 2009 letter (13 items).**

**SDIA Topics of Concerns discussed:**

1. SB 10 / 1510 governance of SDCRAA conflicts of interest in ALUC matters.
2. Land Use Compatibility Plan updates
3. FAA use of 250 degree departure headings
4. California Auditors Report – year 2000 regarding noise mitigation gates for departures
5. Proposition A – MCAS joint use and Air Installation Compatibility Use Zones (AICUZ)
6. Miramar vs. East Elliott – as alternative site for SDIA
7. Terminal Development Projects – parking garage and consolidated rental car facilities
8. Regional Aviation Strategic Plan
9. “Destination Lindbergh” - Intermodal Transit Center
10. High Speed Rail

Senator Kehoe agreed to press SDCRAA for environmental impact reports on all ALUCP updates. Kehoe agreed to follow up on extending Destination Lindbergh Ad Hoc Committee to resolve North Harbor Drive traffic problems (T-2 Parking / CONRAC). Kehoe recommended Congresswoman Susan Davis to resolve FAA use of 250 degree departure heading concerns. Kehoe will look into SB 10 / 1510 perceived or actual conflicts of interest between SDCRAA and ALUC.

Kehoe requested a follow up letter to address specific action items. Suhail Khalil agreed to provide follow-up letter on behalf of PCPB Airport Committee and Councilman Kevin Faulconer agreed to support efforts and help address community concerns.
