The Peninsula Community Planning Board is now accepting applications for a board vacancy. At their meeting May 20th it announced receiving a resignation from Board Member Dr. Mathew Sanicki. Dr. Sanicki has two years left in his term.

Per By Laws of the Board it has 120 days to fill this vacancy from the time it was acknowledged by the Board which will be 120 day from the 20th day of May. The vacancy will be filled by the PCPB at the next regular meeting on June 17th.

A candidate for membership shall, prior to being elected by the Board provide proof of eligibility and fill out an application and present it to the board Secretary or to the Chair. Applications are available at the web site www.pcpb.net or from Chair Charles Mellor at phone number 222-2240. Additional info can be found on the web site. Applications will be accepted until 12:00 noon on June 16th. Each candidate will have an opportunity to address the board for five minutes prior to the board election.

An eligible person is defined as being at least 18 years of age and a Peninsula property owner or Peninsula community resident or a local business person with a business address in the Peninsula community, at which, employees or operators of the business are located and has attended one meeting of the PCPB.

By Laws require that this announcement be made in a local newspaper and that it be promulgated as much as possible so that interested parties have ample opportunity to make application.
