

Peninsula Planning Board Candidate Qualifications

To qualify as a candidate you must be at least 18 years of age, and shall be affiliated with the community as a:

- (1) property owner, who is an individual identified as the sole or partial owner of record, of a real property (either developed or undeveloped), within the community planning area, or
- (2) resident, who is an individual whose primary address of residence is an address in the community planning area, or
- (3) local business person, who is a local business or not-for-profit owner or operator at a non-residential real property address in the community planning area.

A Recognized Community Member may become an Eligible Candidate by (a) attending one meeting of the Peninsula Community Planning Board's regular meetings occurring during the twelve month period prior to the March General Election, with such attendance acknowledged by the planning board chair or secretary or reflected in minutes, and (b) submitting a completed application to the election subcommittee.
