- A. Parliamentary Items - Call to Order
Called to order 6:16 pm
Board Members Present: Chair Javier Saunders, Co-chair Christine Smith, Sam Laub, Andrew Hollingworth. Appointed Community Members Present: Paul Grimes
- B. Review and Approve Minutes: Motion (SamL, 2nd AndrewH) to approve June 10, 2026 minutes. Approved 5-0
- C. Non-agenda public comment – no items
- D. Issues for Discussion or To Potentially Take Action On:
 - a. Discuss and request community input for Capital Improvement Priorities (CIP) for the FY 2028-2031 Planning Process. (*Javier Saunders*)
JavierS presented an updated CIP list based on inputs received via the online form on PCPB's website. 70-80% of public requests were related to fixing the Loma Portal streetlights – so that item was moved to position one on the list. Four other projects were added to the list for a total of 9 CIP requests: 1) Repair Loma Portal streetlights, 2) Liberty Station (NTC) aquatic center, 3) Cabrillo recreation center improvements, 4) Sunset Cliffs seawall repairs, 5) Sidewalk improvement on Lomaland Dr, 6) Traffic calming on Catalina Ave, 7) Walkway connecting Oliphant St and Quimby St, 8) Add additional bleachers in Point Loma Park and 9) Nimitz Blvd Streetscape improvements. Motion (AndrewH, 2nd SamL) to move the list forward to PCPB. Approved 5-0.
 - b. Discuss potential position and action on Approved City Council [SB 79](#) map and Tier 2 Transit Stop designations. (*Javier Saunders*)
Motion (JavierS, 2nd AndrewH) to write a letter to SANDAG board to be approved at the July PCPB board stating that the SANDAG board should be responsible for approving the staff selection of SB79 TOD stops since the selection of stops is controversial and has significant impact on communities. Approved 5-0.
